In order to prepare yourselves for the start of History A-Level, and familiarise yourself with some of the content and skills you will need, we would like to complete the following tasks before we start in September:

Unit 1C The Tudors: England, 1485-1603

The course covers issues of change, continuity, cause and consequence in this period through the following key questions:

- How effectively did the Tudors restore and develop the powers of the monarchy?
- In what ways and how effectively was England governed during this period?
- How did relations with foreign powers change and how was the succession secured?
- How did English society and economy change and with what effects?
- How far did intellectual and religious ideas change and develop and with what effects?
- How important was the role of key individuals and groups and how were they affected by developments?

Task 1	Research Richard III. You could possibly include the archaeological work that was completed in the last few years in Leicester, and his burial in 2015 in Leicester Cathedral.
Task 2	Find out why Richard III lost the throne of England: How he usurped the throne His actions as King ,1483-85 Henry Tudor's claim to the throne What happened at the Battle of Bosworth in 1485.
Task 3	Create a Royal family tree from the reign of Edward III to Elizabeth I.

Unit 2Q The American Dream: Reality and Illusion, 1945-1980

The course covers the challenges faced by the USA at home and abroad as it emerged from the Second World War as a Superpower. For many Americans, post-war prosperity realised the 'American dream' but the prosperity was not shared by all and significant problems at home and abroad challenged the extent to which the 'American dream' was a reality. It explores concepts and ideas such as American identity at home and abroad, anti-communism, social equality, ethnic identities and federal versus states' rights.
