 - (b) Cognitive – memory/problem solving/eyewitness testimony
 - (c) Developmental – child development/childcare
 - (d) Psychopathology – abnormal behaviour/personality disorders, phobias, depression, OCD, treatments (medication or therapy)
2. You will be asked to present your article to the class. This can be done with a short PowerPoint presentation to show the article and how it links to one of the areas of psychology above.
