Re: GCSE Results Day and Year 12 Registration – Thursday 22 August

(a) Collection of GCSE Results

GCSE results will be available on Thursday 23 August and your son/daughter may arrive at school from **9.00am until 10.00am** to collect them. Although the telephone switchboard will be operated from 9.00am until 3.00pm on Results Day, we are unable to give results by telephone or email.

(b) What to do if you are not able to collect your results

If it is not possible to attend on this date you can either send a stamped addressed envelope to Mrs Quinn c/o Saint Gregory's and the results will be sent to you, or you can give permission for a representative to collect your results on your behalf. In either case please complete the attached form and return it to Mrs Quinn by Monday 15 July at the latest.

(c) Confirmation of Intention to Join The New Sixth and advice on subject choices

We are delighted that many of our Year 11 students will be staying on for the sixth form. On Results Day students who wish to take up their offer of a place in Year 12 must confirm their intention and their subject choices. For many this will be an easy process as their GCSE results will meet the entry requirements for the subjects they have chosen to study at A level.

If students need to rethink their original subject choices there will be senior staff available to offer advice on sixth form courses on the day. If more time is needed to consider which new subjects to study then Miss Butler, Director of Sixth Form, will be available until the following Tuesday. (d) Confirmation of Intention to Join The New Sixth if you are not present on Results Day

It is important that if you are not present for Results Day but do intend to take up your place in the sixth form, that you contact the school to confirm your intention to attend in September. This can be done by calling the sixth form direct line. If we have not heard from you by Tuesday 27th August, we will assume that you do not wish to take up your place in the sixth form.

(e) If you are not sure of your plans after GCSE, or are disappointed with your results

On results day, senior staff will be available to help support you to make the best decision for your future whether that be to continue in education, training or employment.
