Book one in a new series.

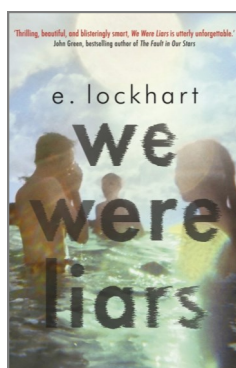


We were Liars by E. Lockhart

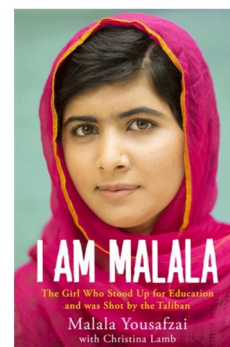

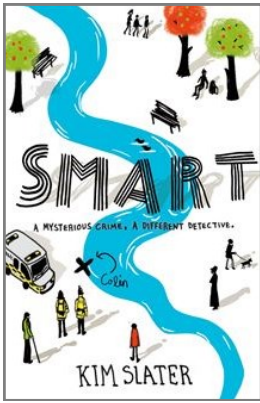
I am Malala by Malala Yousafzai

A 'must read' biography.



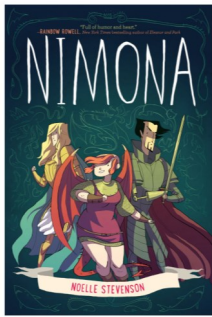
Smart by Kim Slater

A short, fast paced mystery crime story.

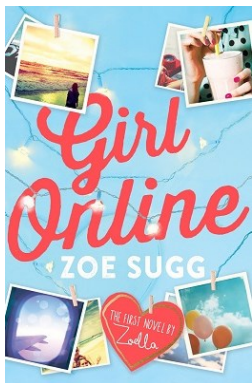
Nimona by Noelle Stevenson
