The Beginning of the new academic year

The arrangements for the beginning of the new academic year are as follows:

Monday 4 September School closed for staff training

Tuesday 5 September Year 7 induction day, Year 12 registration, plus other new students.

Year 7 students please line up outside the hall in the Piazza by 8.45 am where they will be met by their tutor. Year 7 students will be in school all day until 3.10pm. Lunch will be available and, although students will be issued with a lunch fob on the first day, we recommend that they bring cash, just in case there are any delays. They should also bring in a cheque for £10 made payable to Saint Gregory's School for a locker. Please note that buses will run as normal but there will be no older students on board except possibly a few Year 12 students.

Year 12 students report to the Learning Resource Centre at 8.50am.

New students beginning in Years 8-11 should report to main reception by 8.35 am and will then be shown into the Bond Pavilion where they will meet their Head of Year.
