## Last year's success

Despite the challenges of COVID-19, the PTFA have maintained income streams through new initiatives and projects. This year, we have raised:

**£487** – PTFA Cookbook

**£242** – EasyFundraising

**£248** – PTFA 100 Club \*soon to be our NEW 50/50 Club

**£1,572** – Pre Loved Uniform Shops

**£5,000** – Donation from the Medlock Trust

## Supported projects

Added to funds raised in 2019-20, this has enabled the PTFA to support a range of projects at school this year, including:

- End of Year Rewards Day treats for all students in all year groups
- A donation to the Leavers' Committees for Year 11 and Year 13
- A donation of £5,000 towards the cost of school development and master planning
- Equipment and supplies for a new Lego Computing Club
- iPads for the PE department to assist with interactive teaching and learning
- Video cameras for GCSE and A Level PE to record performance and evidence for exams
- £500 towards specialist SEND equipment
- £500 towards Pastoral facilities and resources




