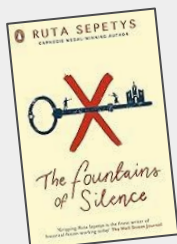

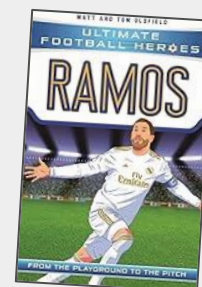


The Fountains of Silence by Ruta Sepetys

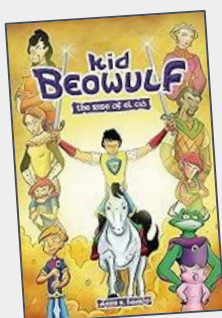


Toro! Toro! by Michael Morpurgo
