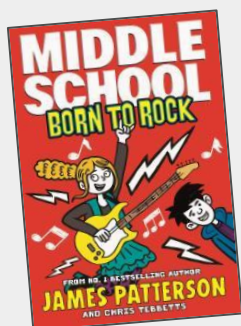

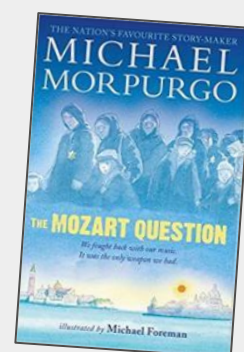


Middle School: Born to Rock by James Patterson

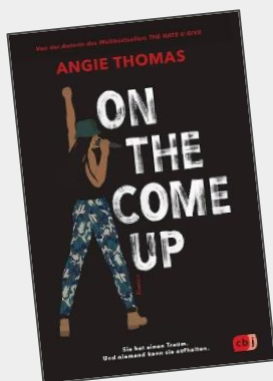
The Mozart Question by Michael Morpurgo
