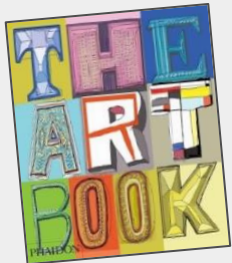

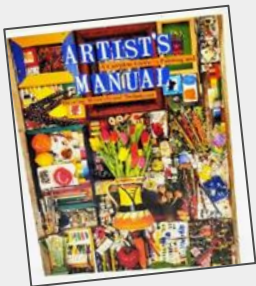
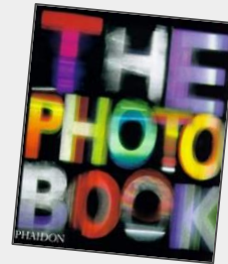


The Art Book New Edition by Phaidon

500 superb images represent the world's best photographers and encompass every sort of photography in this eye-catching and engrossing book.

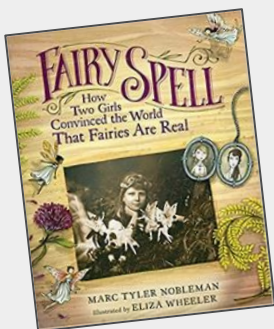
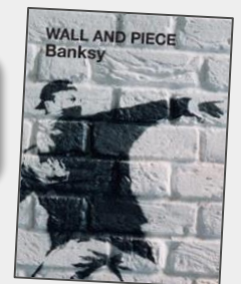


The Artist's Manual by Angela Gair

Art work by the most famous street artist in the world, Banksy, accompanied with comments by the artist.

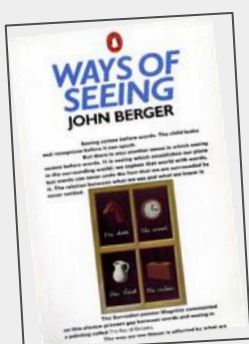
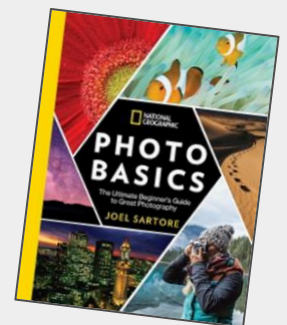


Fairy Spell by Marc Tyler Nobleman
