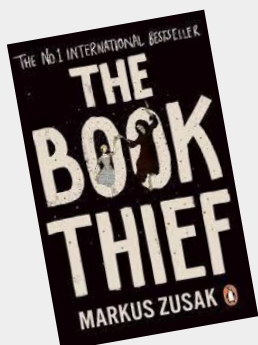

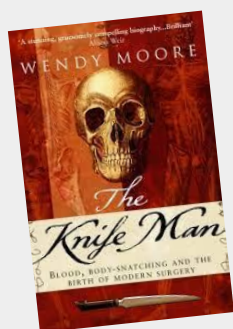


The Book Thief by Markus Zusak

This novel is set in Nazi Germany and follows a young girl named Liesel Meminger, who steals books and shares them with her neighbours and the Jewish man hiding in her basement.

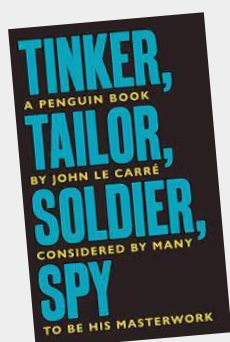
All The Light We Cannot See by Anthony Doerr

Set during World War II, this novel interweaves the stories of a blind French girl and a German boy whose paths cross during the Nazi occupation of France.



The Knife Man by Wendy Moore

A historical account of the life and work of John Hunter, an 18th-century surgeon and anatomist, shedding light on the development of modern surgery and medical practices.



Tinker, Tailor, Soldier, Spy by John le Carré

A classic spy novel set during the Cold War, it follows George Smiley, a retired British intelligence officer, as he is drawn back into the world of espionage to uncover a Soviet mole within the British intelligence service.

Bridge of Spies: A True Story of the Cold War by Giles Whittell

This non-fiction work recounts the real-life events that inspired the movie "Bridge of Spies," focusing on the exchange of captured American U-2 pilot Francis Gary Powers for Soviet spy Rudolf Abel during the Cold War.
