


KEY STAGE 4 SUGGESTED READING LIST

Just Listen by Sarah Dessen

Isolated from friends who believe the worst because she has not been truthful with them, sixteen-year-old Annabel finds an ally in classmate Owen, who helps her face and share what really happened at the end-of-the-year party that changed her life.





If I Stay by Gayle Foreman

While in a coma following an horrific car accident that killed her parents and younger brother, seventeen-year-old Mia, a gifted cellist, weighs up whether to live with her grief or join her family in death. Contains strong language.
